Operational hours: Friday, October 13, 2023, from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Saturday, October 14, 2023, from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Sunday, October 15, 2023, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Rules:

- 1. All Vendors must have liability insurance.
 - A. Additional insured on your policy must be in place as follows:
 - The Lions Club of Waterford, 53 Church St. West, Waterford, ON, N0E 1Y0.
 - B. Additional insured on your policy must be in place as follows:
 - The Corporation of Norfolk, 185 Robinson Street, Suite 100, Simcoe, ON, N3Y 5L6.
 - C. Certificate of Insurance providing proof of coverage for the event with a minimum
 - \$2 Million liability coverage.
 - D. A copy of the Vendor Certificate of Insurance to be sent to outdoorvendors@pumpkinfest.com and provided no less than 15 days prior to the event.
 - E. A copy of the Vendor Certificate of Insurance to be sent to The Corporation of Norfolk.
- 2. Vendor must complete the attached Business License Application and <u>all applicable forms and</u> forward to clerks@norfolkcounty.ca along with a copy of their insurance coverage for the Event no less than 30 days prior to event.
- 3. **Vendor must complete** the Special Event Food Provider Application from the Haldimand Norfolk County Health Unit (HNHU) to be able to participate in Pumpkinfest. These forms must be submitted at least 60 days in advance of the event. Forms are available at HNHU specialevents@hnhu.org
- 4. Licensing fees and equipment inspections are Vendors responsibility.
- 5. Vendors are to supply all cords, connections, and adaptors. All cords, cord connectors (twist lock type) and cables to be approved type c/w rating before any electrical connection will be completed by a qualified electrician that represents the Pumpkinfest organization.
- 6. As an outdoor event, you are responsible to deal with all forms of weather, please be prepared. The festival does not have items on hand to assist with items like excess water or wind.
- 7. The organizers have the authority to close operations of the vendor on site if not abiding by rules.
- 8. No Refunds.
